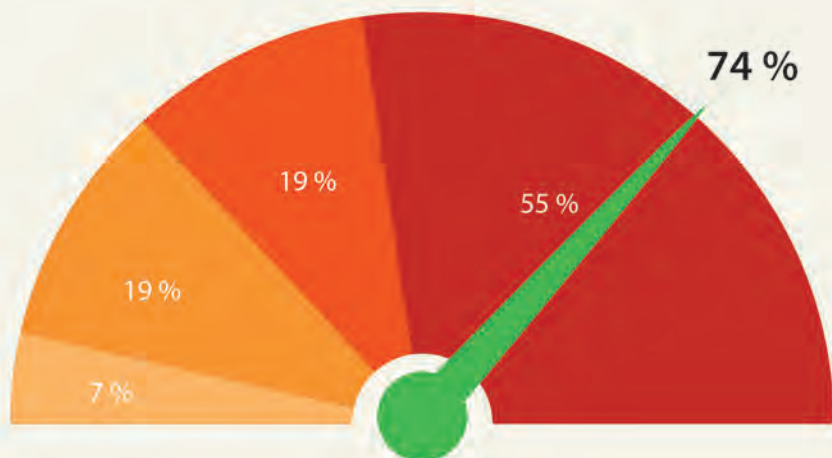
The amount of **knowledge transfer was great**. The **accommodation and food was very good** most days and satisfactory at the others. Snacks were the best, although **coffee was horrible**.
